

Travel arrangements

Please make your own travel arrangements to and from Kenya and book your accommodation with the hotel directly.





Airport

The nearest international airport is Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO). The airport is located 24km (approx. 30 mins. drive) from the Safari Park Hotel.

Transfers

<u>Airport</u>: It is highly recommended that you book your airport transfer directly with the hotel you are staying at. The Safari Park Hotel charges approximately USD 40.00/transfer.

<u>Transfers between hotels</u>: Please make your own arrangements for travel from the hotel you are staying at to the venue and back. IBFD does not provide any shuttles.

Payment of the registration fee

Payments can only be made <u>online</u>, via credit card. Payment on-site and/or in cash is <u>not</u> permitted.

Kindly note that payment in full has to be received prior to the start of the meeting to gain access to the conference.

Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA)

All visitors who intend to travel to the Republic of Kenya **must have an approved** Electronic Travel Authorisation (eTA) **before** the start of their journey.

The section "How to Apply" provides useful information when submitting your eTA.

Confirmation of your <u>flight</u> and <u>accommodation</u> and a <u>passport</u> valid for a minimum of 6 months beyond visa issuance and/or date of entry are required for the eTA.

Applications are processed within 3-5 working days. However, applicants are strongly advised to submit the eTA request as soon as possible in case of delays.

General information about Kenya

Geography

The geography of Kenya is diverse, varying amongst its 47 counties. Kenya has a coastline on the Indian Ocean, which contains swamps of East African mangroves. Inland are broad plains and numerous hills.

Climate

The climate of Kenya varies by location, from mostly cool every day to always warm/hot by mid-afternoon, with elevation being the major factor in determining temperature levels. In Nairobi, at 1,798 m. (5,899 ft), temperatures range from 9-27°C (49-80°F).

In May, it can be slightly chilly in the evening, so please bring an extra jacket or a shawl.

Currency

Kenyan Schilling (KES)

US dollars are accepted almost everywhere in Kenya.

It is recommended to bring some US dollars in cash, as not all ATMs allow cash withdrawals from foreign bank accounts.

USD 1 = approx. KES 160; EUR 1 = approx. KES 170

Drinking water


It is not safe to drink tap water in Kenya. To avoid health problems, use only bottled or filtered water for drinking and brushing your teeth.

Language

Official: Swahili and English

Plastic

Please note, all kinds of plastic bags are illegal, and bringing in plastic will be fined. Please





be advised to leave plastic bags on the plane before entering the airport.

Time zone

The time zone in Kenya is UTC+3. Kenya observes Eastern Africa Time all year.

Vaccination

Kenya does not require mandatory vaccination.

However, you are strongly advised to consult your travel doctor for advice.
