IBFD's Library and Information Centre is widely regarded as the world's leading resource facility in the field of international and comparative taxation. The extensive collection, which covers almost every country in the world, comprises approximately 19,000 books and subscriptions to over 1,100 journals, official gazettes, loose-leaf services, CD-ROMs and online databases, over 8,000 law texts and official documents from countries all over the world and access to 600 websites of relevant resources such as governments, universities and law firms.

This qualitative collection is expanding every day.

Visiting hours

The Library catalogue is available 24 hours a day at our web site www.ibfd.org, but it is also possible to visit IBFD's Library and Information Centre. The state-of-the-art multimedia facilities are located at IBFD's Head Office building and contain a very large reading room and 11 work units, each equipped with a PC. Alternatively, the Library is equipped with WIFI, to enable visitors the use of their own laptop.

Consult our dynamic catalogue online

The catalogue of IBFD's Library and Information Centre is available online at www.ibfd.org 24 hours a day.

You can either file a simple search request via the Quick Search engine or set up a more extensive search via the Power Search engine. Searches can be based on keywords, author's name, text of the abstract, title of publication, subject, series, etc. Here you can also check an overview of new books, laws and articles that have been added to the Library collection.

Free visit for research purposes

IBFD's Library and Information Centre may be visited for research purposes. You can benefit from the multimedia facilities located at IBFD's Head Office. The Library staff will assist you if you need help in finding literature or information on how to use the available databases, the PCs or any other services and products. You may use the Library facilities for a longer period of time. These services are free of charge. It is, however, advisable to book early to ensure the availability of a work unit.

Order information of your interest

The collection may only be consulted at the Library and external loan of publications is not possible. However, copies of documents and source materials can be ordered and will be sent by mail, fax or e-mail (if available in digital format). Contact the Library for more information on the charges.

Individual and professional approach

The Library staff consists of trained information specialists who are ready to help you find an answer to your queries. If you need a specific document, information about the catalogue or general advice in finding literature, do not hesitate to ask. Every attempt will be made to answer telephone and e-mail queries within 24 hours. If the information specialists do not have the answer themselves, they are supported by an international team of experts in international and comparative tax law who very likely will.

Alerting service by e-mail

Library TaxFeeds is the Library's alerting service by e-mail. It informs you on a regular basis about topics, articles, books, legislation and other media, which have recently been added to the collection of the Library. After you have consulted one of our information specialists we will set up a tailor-made profile based on a selection of the countries and languages of your interest. With this service you will hardly ever miss out on a publication in your field of expertise.
