

## Take the Half Day 'Wildlife in the City' Excursion

We will take you behind the scenes, walking in the steps of the animals' caretakers for the experience of living at the Wildlife Centre.

This two-hour excursion also builds in a scenic range of cliffs overlooking Lake Victoria, but nobody is allowed to dive into the water! Instead, you will be allowed to get a hands-on experience, feed the birds and animals (pre-permitted foods only - NO humans!) and perhaps adopt an animal or two!

## Take the Half Day 'Discovery of the Buganda Kingdom' Excursion

This culturally rich excursion is the stuff the European explorers of old lived for. We will start with a visit to the Parliament of the Buganda Kingdom, "The Bulange", for a guided tour of one of Africa's strongest traditional kingdoms. Thereafter, you will walk the special "King's Mile", to the Lubiri Palace but politely skirt round the special pathway reserved only for the Kabaka himself. At the Lubiri you may enjoy the atmosphere of one of the homes of the King of Buganda - and we can dream of the opportunity to take a selfie with the King himself, but only dream!

As you tour the Buganda Kingdom, you will visit the largest man-made (dug) lake in Uganda, created for the pleasure of the Buganda Kings, and enjoy the large bird numbers that have their home on the shores of the lake.

The trip will culminate in a visit to the Martyrs Shrine at Munyonyo, one of the famous locations where many young men and women from Buganda were killed because of their faith. At each of the different stops, you are encouraged to pick up some authentic Ugandan souvenirs by which you will remember this time in the Pearl of Africa.
