

## Exciting excursions for your time in Uganda:

Uganda, known as the Pearl of Africa, is home to some of the most exotic wildlife and birds in the world. While in Uganda, we are excited to offer you the opportunity to tour this beautiful country and give you options of places to visit and things to do. Each option includes transportation, accommodation, activities and a professional guide.

### **OPTION 1:**

#### **Chasing Chimps and Lions (3 days):**

For this option, you shall go chimp tracking in the Kibale National Park, home to Uganda's largest population of chimpanzees and a range of other primates. You will stay at the luxurious lodge overlooking the crater Lake Kyaninga (for one - 1 - night).

After the chimp tracking, you will go on to the Queen Elizabeth National Park and stay at the Kasenyi Safari Camp that overlooks a large watering hole for the animals in the Park. You will go on a boat ride on the Kazinga Channel, a game drive (hunting for lions mostly) and a crater lake drive (interesting to see the effects of the region's volcanic past).

After one (1) night in this Park, you will travel back to Kampala, to your preferred drop off point. Of course there will be time set aside for souvenir shopping at the beautiful art & crafts markets.

### **OPTION 2 (4 days):**

#### **Journeying the River Nile:**

This excursion is all about the River Nile and starts with a trip to Jinja where the River's journey begins. This is also for the more adventurous spirit in you. From Kampala (your preferred pickup point), the first stop will be at the Mabira Forest for a quick zip lining



thrill over the thick forest canopy. After this you will go whitewater rafting at the Wild Waters Lodge (you will stay for one - 1 - night). As if this is not enough of an adrenaline fix, you will also get to go bungee jumping over the River Nile.

The second part of the trip will take you to the Murchison Falls National Park via the Zziwa Rhino Sanctuary. At this Sanctuary, you will visit with the White Rhino (endangered species as you know) and then head on to the National Park where you will experience the famous Murchison Falls. You will stay at the Murchison River Lodge (for two - 2 - nights) and for the activities; there is the stop at the top of the Falls to see the mighty River Nile squeeze through the small gorge, then enjoy a boat ride to the bottom of the Falls, a sunset cruise and of course go on a game ride around the Park.

You can also visit these places separately, if you so wish (**2 days' option**).

### **OPTION 3:**

#### **Climbing Hills for Lions and Gorillas (4 days):**

This is another scenic excursion through the calming and incredibly beautiful south western Uganda. You will visit the Queen Elizabeth National Park for the tree climbing lions, spectacular crater lakes and magnificent elephants. You will stay at the Kasenyi Safari Camp for one (1) night and will go on a boat ride on the Kazinga Channel, a game drive and a crater lake drive (interesting to see the effects of the region's volcanic past). After leaving the Park, you will then visit the Bwindi Impenetrable Forest (a UNESCO World Heritage site) to see the close relatives of the human race. Seeing the gorillas is a magical experience and despite the trekking through the forest (can be arduous), spending an hour with these gentle beasts makes it worthwhile. You will stay at the Silverback Lodge for two (2) nights before heading back to Kampala or your preferred drop off point.
